The Wesley L. Bender Scholarship Fund

A scholarship of \$500 per semester will be awarded to a qualifying individual, who is relative to an employee in the explosives industry or a related field, which wishes to pursue collegiate studies.

Scholarship Eligibility: Graduating high school seniors or students already enrolled in college that are related to an employee in the Explosives Industry or another industry that utilizes explosives may apply for the scholarship.

Judging Committee: All received scholarship applications will be reviewed and judged by a panel, consisting of the Chapter Officers and Board, including the past President of the GWC or their respective designees.

Scholarship Disbursement: The winning applicant will be issued the scholarship on an annual basis, totaling five hundred dollars per semester.

Academic Requirement: The winning applicant must maintain a grade point average of 3.0 in order to remain eligible for scholarship.

2. A Letter of Recommendation
3. A 300-500 word statement of your past scholastic and personal accomplishments, including your plans for a career
